The Maritime Connects Initiative is a new initiative designed to increase trade between the UK and the rest of the Commonwealth. It has been established to help drive economic growth in the UK and throughout the Commonwealth's 52 member countries, representing 1/3 of the world's population and combined GDP of \$10.4 trillion.

Developed by AMPP Group in partnership with the Commonwealth Enterprise and Investment Council, *Maritime Connects,* has been designed to bring companies from across the Commonwealth together on a members-only digital platform. It will enable companies to identify and network with potential new customers, suppliers and partners across key global industry sectors, including professional and financial services, manufacturing, wholesale and retail.
